All projects and associated plans are also subject to the um requirements outlined in the Kitsap County Stormwater Manual. This checklist does not preclude the professional judgment to evaluate and manage risk associated with design, construction, and operation of ion BMPs. If your project will infiltrate greater than 5,000 square feet of hard surface area, an alternate test d is required.
The	Source of water. If no water is available on project site, bring at least 36 gallons for test from November to March; or 60 gallons for April through October. Ruler or tape measure (60" minimum length)
Part I.	SUBSURFACE INVESTIGATION:
1.	Dig a hole using a post hole digger to the depth required per Table A below (2-feet below proposed facility in the wet season and 3-feet below the proposed facility in the dry season) and approximately 5-feet from the proposed infiltration facility. (See the footnote at the end of Table A – depth is measured from the bottom of the proposed infiltration facility.)
2.	Record total depth of hole from surrounding ground surface: feet
3.	While digging the hole, did you:
	a. Hit hard pan? (i.e. hardened soil that is like concrete) b. Encounter standing water or seepage in the hole?  Yes No Yes No
4.	If you answered "yes" to either (13a) or (13b), then infiltration is not feasible for this site. No further testing is required. Stop here.
